We tasted white kits, red kits, young kits, mature kits, and kits blended with other wines and fruits. It was also interesting to see how adding 25% of Steve's WineExpert Syrah to his 2021 Chambourcin and Lisa's Finer Wine Kit Syrah to her 2021 Norton that improved their wines.
